

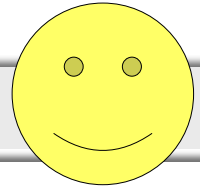

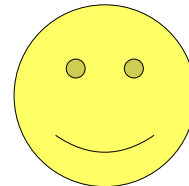

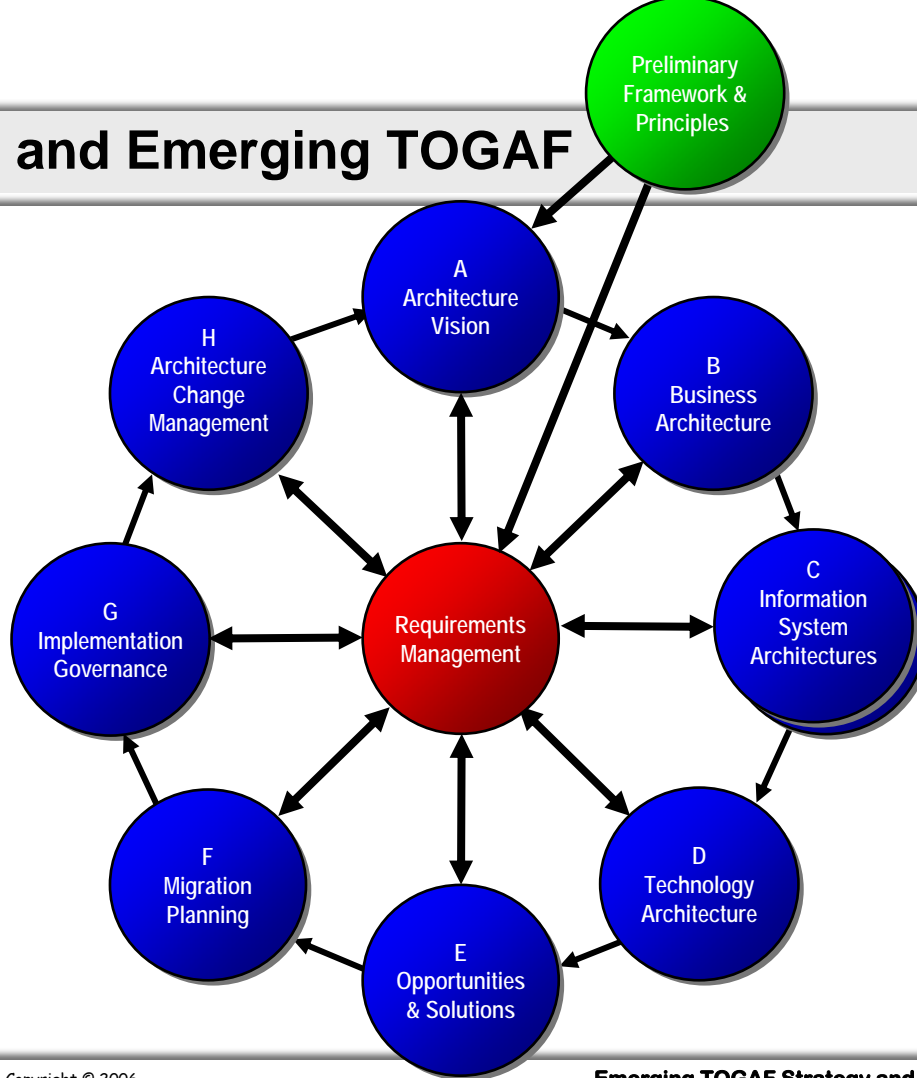

- **Will the next version TOGAF meet these challenges?**

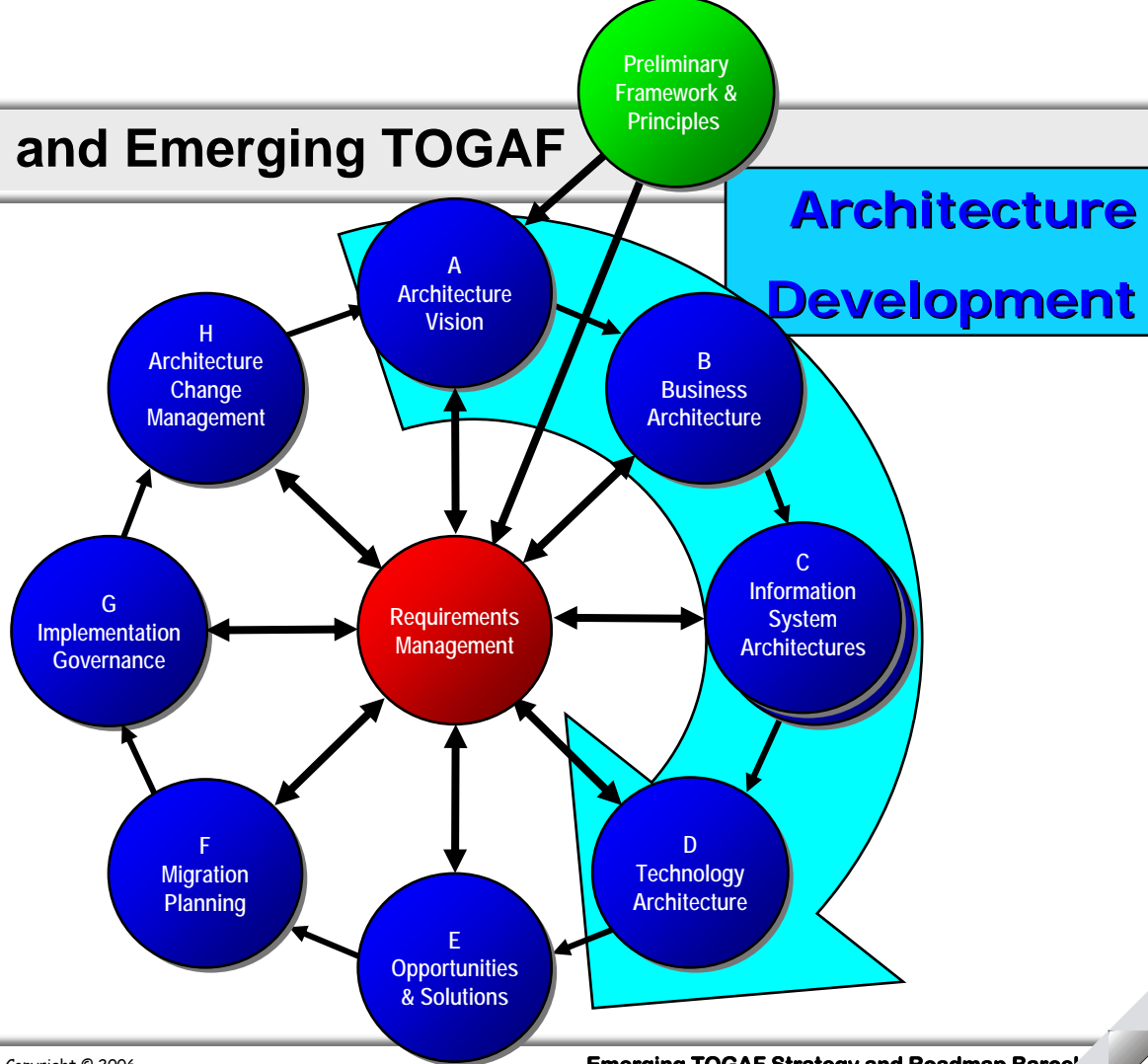

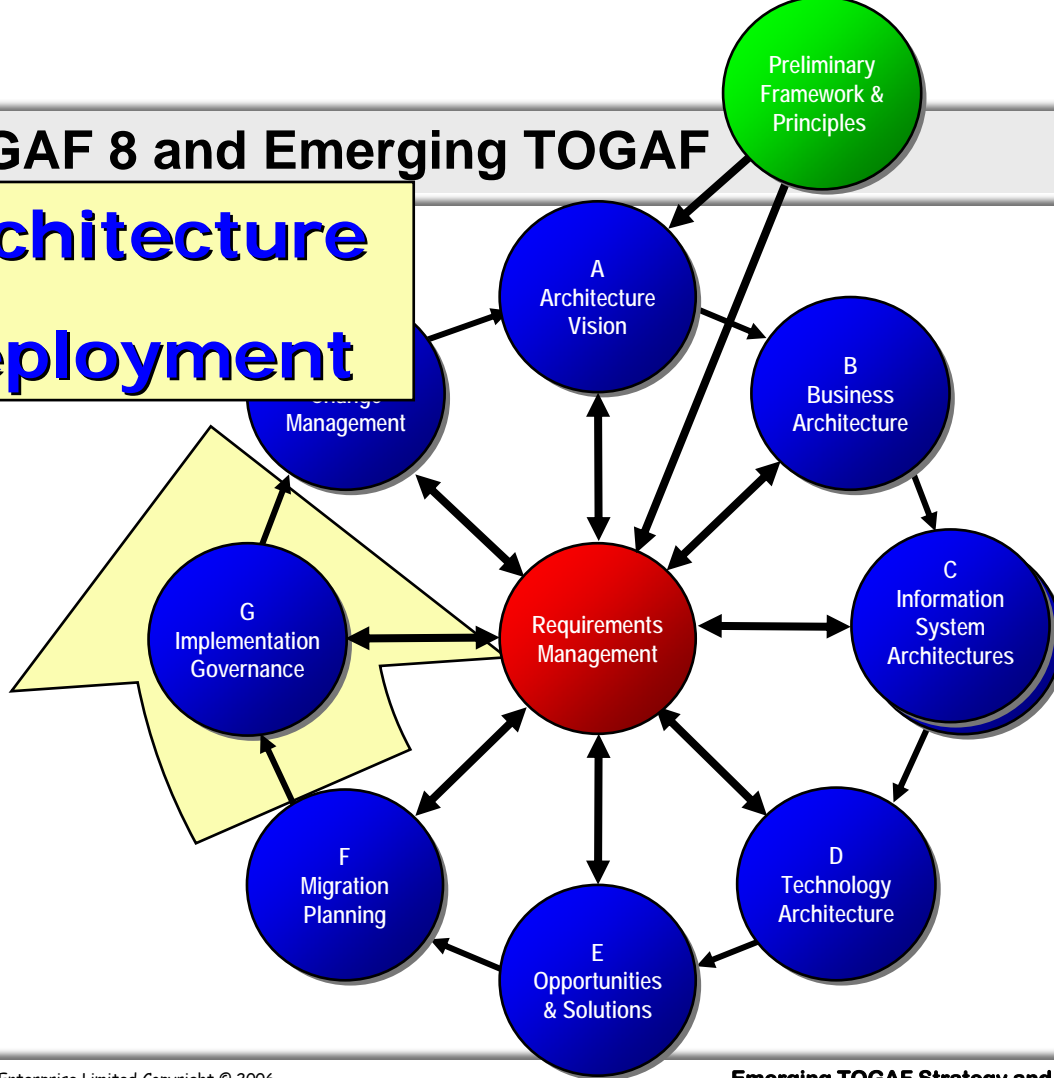

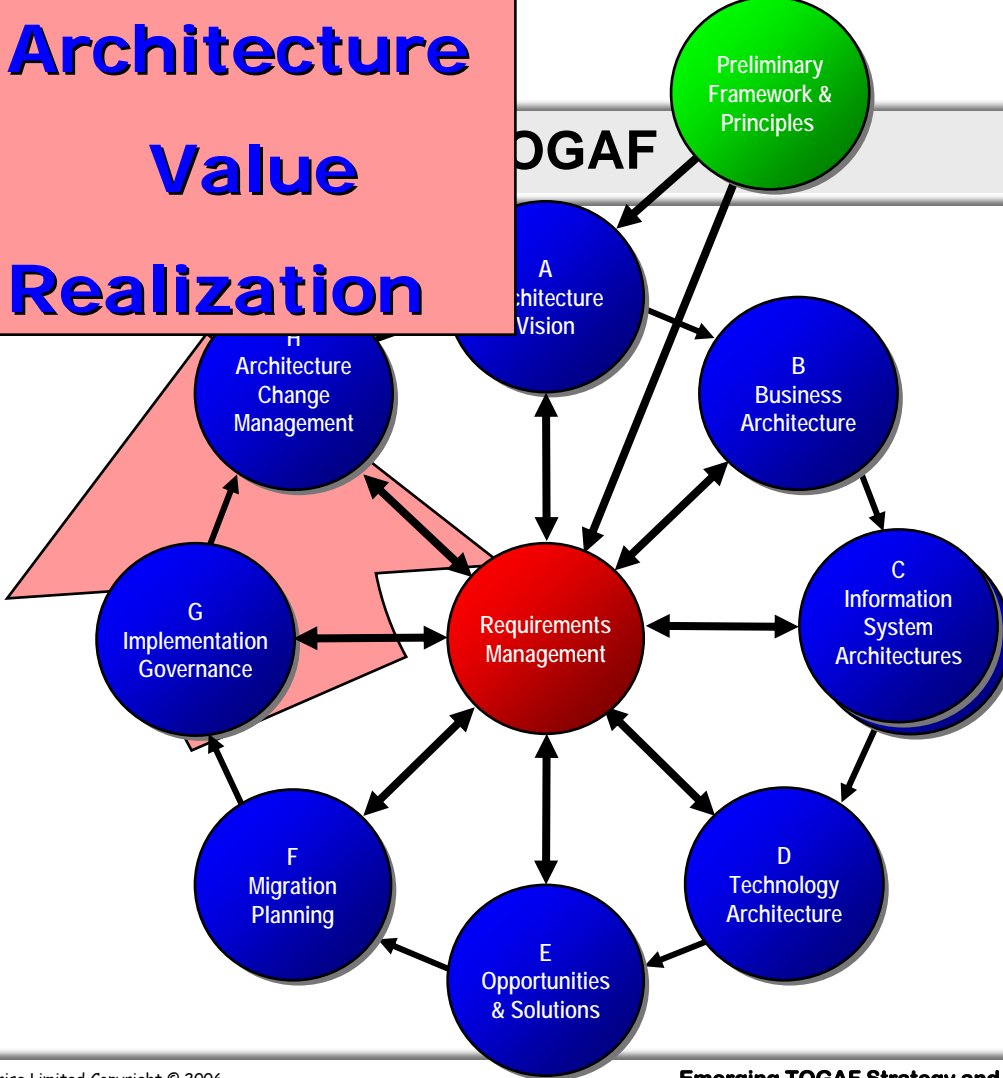

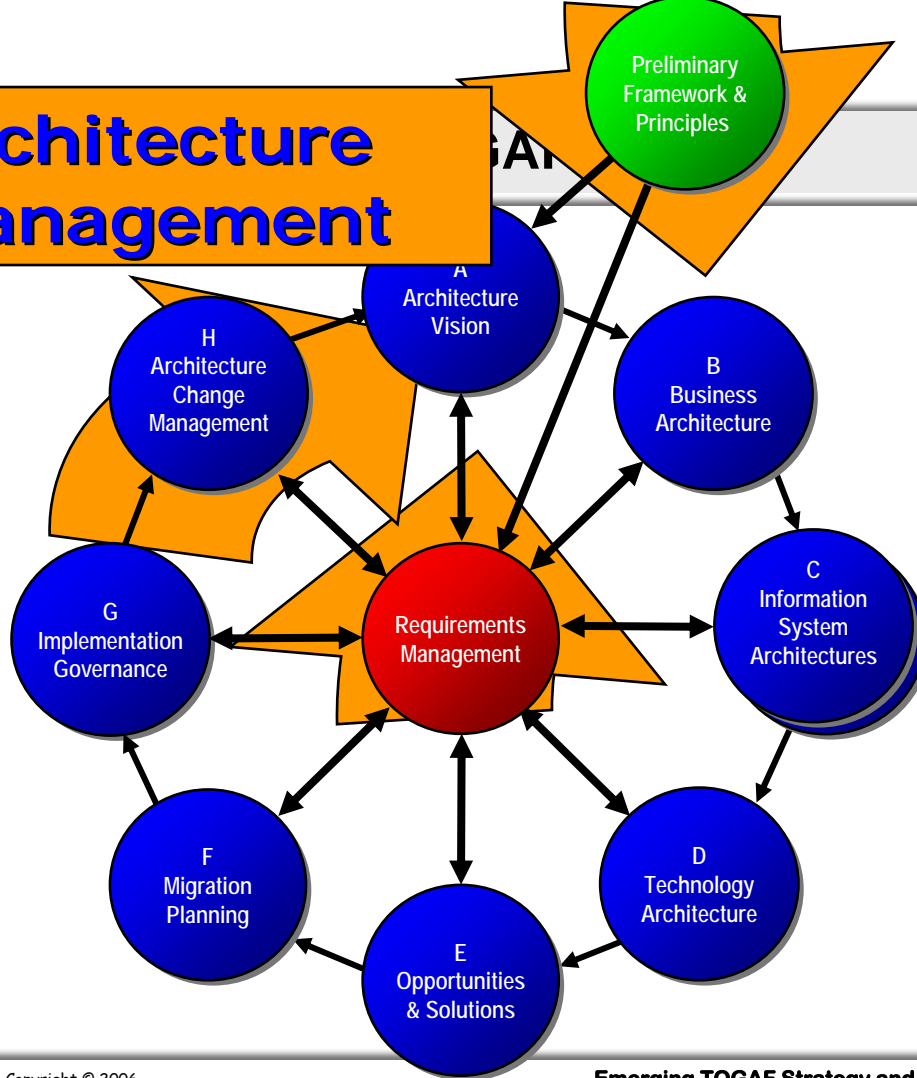
Architecture Deployment



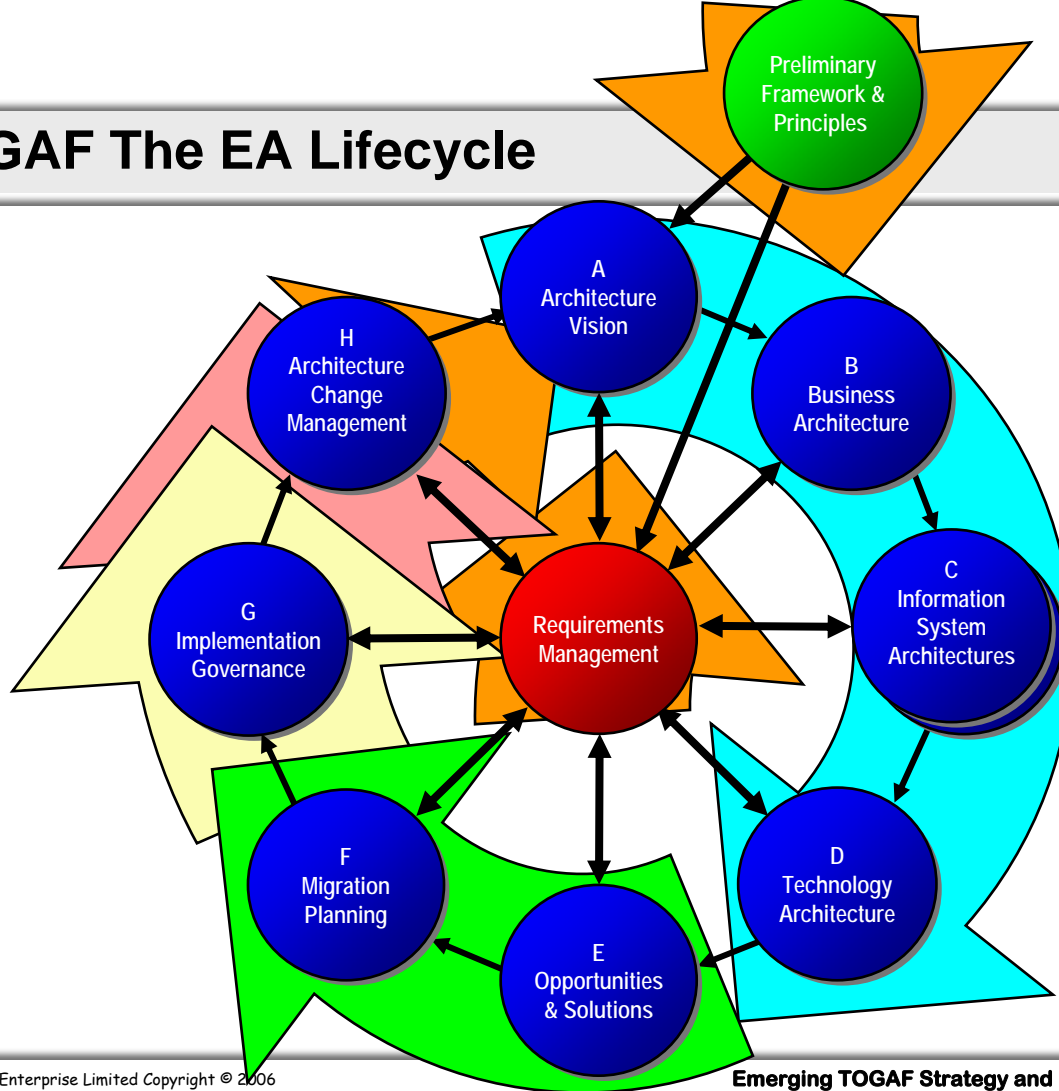
Architecture Value Realization

- **1. Refresh The Architecture Development Method to encompass and develop a variety of trends in architectures**

- **2. Bring The Architecture Development Method up-to-date with business change management to synergize with business transformation programs**

- **3 Improve the Solutions Architecture and Deployment capability so that we can link with best practice systems methodologies**

- **4. Manage the Architecture Lifecycle and demonstrate how Enterprise Architecture adds value to Service Delivery methods and tools e.g ITIL**

The TOGAF EA Lifecycle Action Plan 5-8

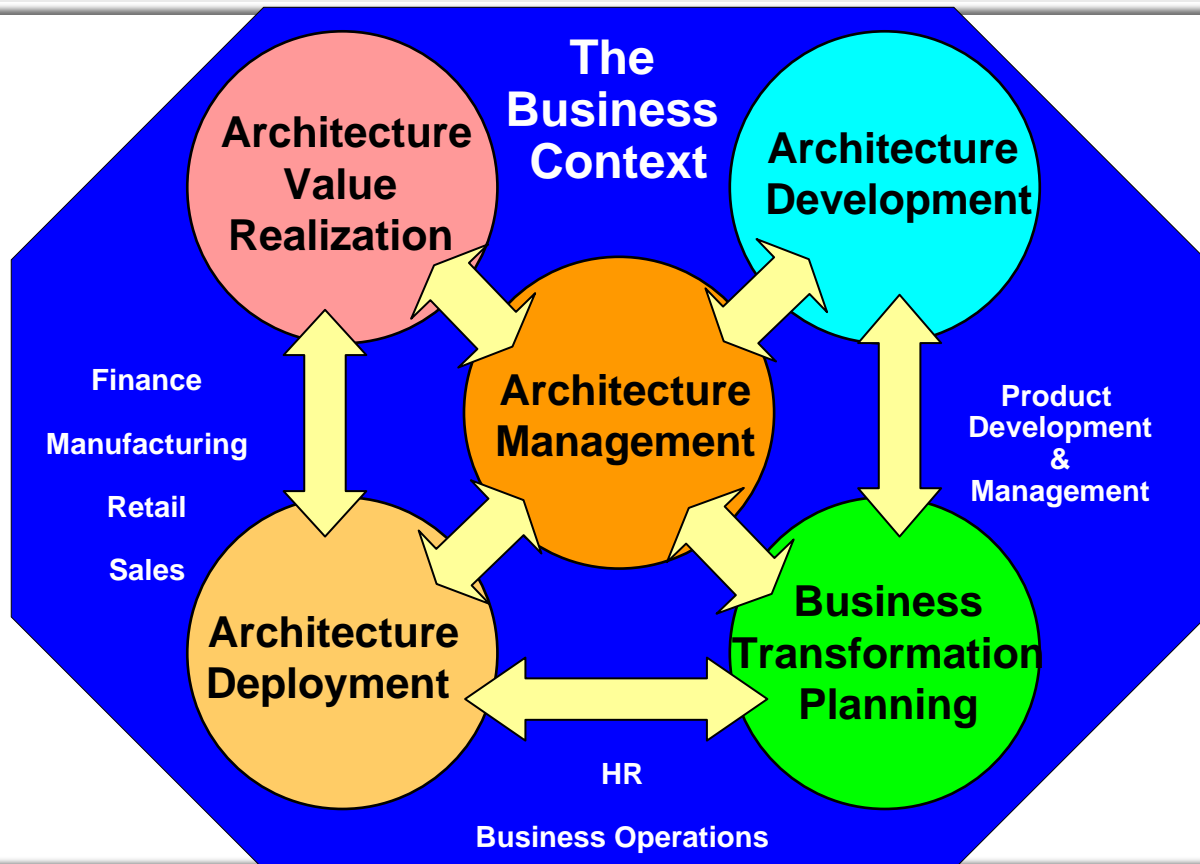
- **5. Show alignment and links with the business for value and benefits realization throughout the lifecycle**
- **6. Add tools and techniques that will enable the new TOGAF to be seen to be the most efficient and best effective method**
- **7. Bring Governance into best practices and show links with business best practice on governance eg COBIT**
- **8. Develop best practice Architecture teams their skills, competencies, tools**

The TOGAF EA Lifecycle Action Plan 9-10

- **9. Adopt industry best practice methods and recommend consistent ways of synergizing with the methods**
- **10. Represent Enterprise Architecture best practice which encompasses and links with all parts of the business including IT and non-IT**

TOGAF Strategy Business Outcomes and Policies

- **1. Safeguard Customer and Vendor Investments in TOGAF for as long as required by the market**
- **2. TOGAF 8.1 will be re-published with the new Open Group web interfaces**
- **3. The TOGAF Naming conventions to differentiate industry and customer requirements.**
- **4. The TOGAF Certifications will be market driven and continue beyond the life of each version.**

TOGAF Strategy Business Outcomes and Policies

- **5. The agreed version of TOGAF 9.0 will form the foundation for discussion of the integration and interworking with other best practice methods e.g. ITIL, COBIT, Zachman. Princ, PMI**

- **6. Integration of Best Practice Methods to commence with development of TOGAF 9.xx versions**

- **7. TOGAF 9.x versions to be developed that will replace TOGAF 7 & 8**

TOGAF Strategy Business Outcomes and Policies

- **8. TOGAF 9.x versions to be developed to further populate the key domains and provide the foundations for global interoperable Enterprise Architecture.**

- **9. TOGAF 9.x versions to be developed for specific industry frameworks and working parties set up to publish Industry variants, tools, techniques and components.**

- **10. TOGAF to be developed as the Open Enterprise Architecture Method.**

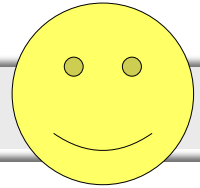

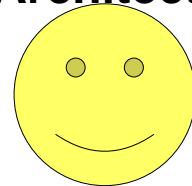
